


Mark 5:40-42

Hebrews 12:7-10

7 If you endure [hupomeno - enduring, patient, patient continuance (waiting)] chastening [paideia], God deals with you as with sons; for what son is he whom the father chastens [paideia] not? 8 But if you be without chastisement [paideia], whereof all are partakers, then are you bastards [nothos - illegitimate children], and not sons [huios]. 9 Furthermore we have had fathers of our flesh which corrected us, and we gave them reverence: shall we not much rather be in subjection unto the Father of spirits, and live? 10 For they verily for a few days chastened us after their own pleasure; but he for our profit, that we might be partakers of his holiness.

2 Timothy 2:23-26

23 But foolish and unlearned questions avoid, knowing that they do gender strifes [mache - fightings]. 24 And the servant of the Lord must not strive [machomai - must not fight]; but be gentle unto all men, apt to teach, patient [anexikakos - tolerating difficulties without becoming out of control], 25 In meekness [prautes - the tame attitude which maintains its focus on God's objective despite circumstances] instructing [paideuo - child training, instructive discipline] those that oppose themselves; if God peradventure will give them repentance [metanoia - change of mind] to the acknowledging [epignosis - full experiential knowledge] of the truth; 26 And that they may recover themselves out of the snare of the devil, who are taken captive by him at his will.

2 Timothy 3:16

All scripture [graphe - writing] is given by inspiration of God [theopneustos - God-breathed], and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof [elegchos - to convince the mind of facts], for correction [epanorthosis - to correct a wrong], for instruction [paideia - child train (discipline)] in righteousness [dikaiosune - how to act right]:

- Interacts
 materially with the

- Physical mind receives input from the 5 senses
- Is where the Sin Nature resides
- The health of the individual has influence upon and by both the soul and the spirit
- Carnal/Flesh "soma"
- Is un-regenerated

SOUL

- Receives input from the Body and interprets it according to emotions, memories, conscience, preferences, and imaginations
- Made up of intellect, sensibility, and will
- The Sin Nature makes its appeals through the soul
- Soul/life "psuche"
- Is un-regenerated

SPIRIT

- Is the place of reasoning
- Is the place where the eternal life resides (the seed of the Father)
- Is the place where we can access the renewed Mind
- Is the place where we are indwelt by the Godhead
- Is where we are partakers of the Divine Nature
- Is regenerated
